An eSIM is an industry-standard digital SIM that allows you to activate a cellular plan from your carrier without using a physical SIM. You can also upgrade devices easily by registering your new device with your cellular network provider. Most Samsung, Google, Huawei, and other Android devices allows five to seven eSIM with one active at a time.

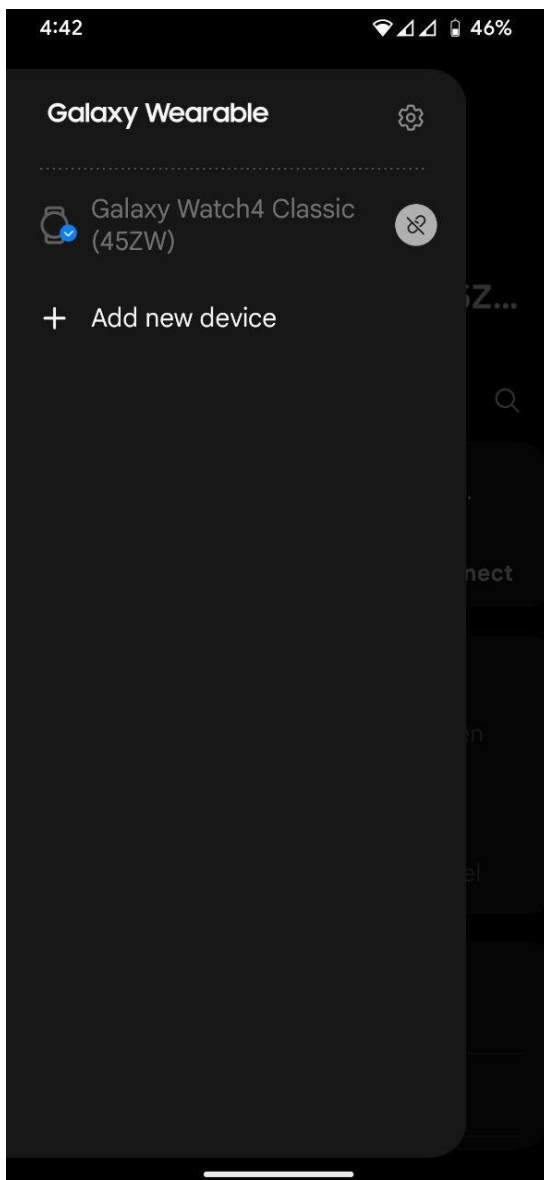

Requirements:

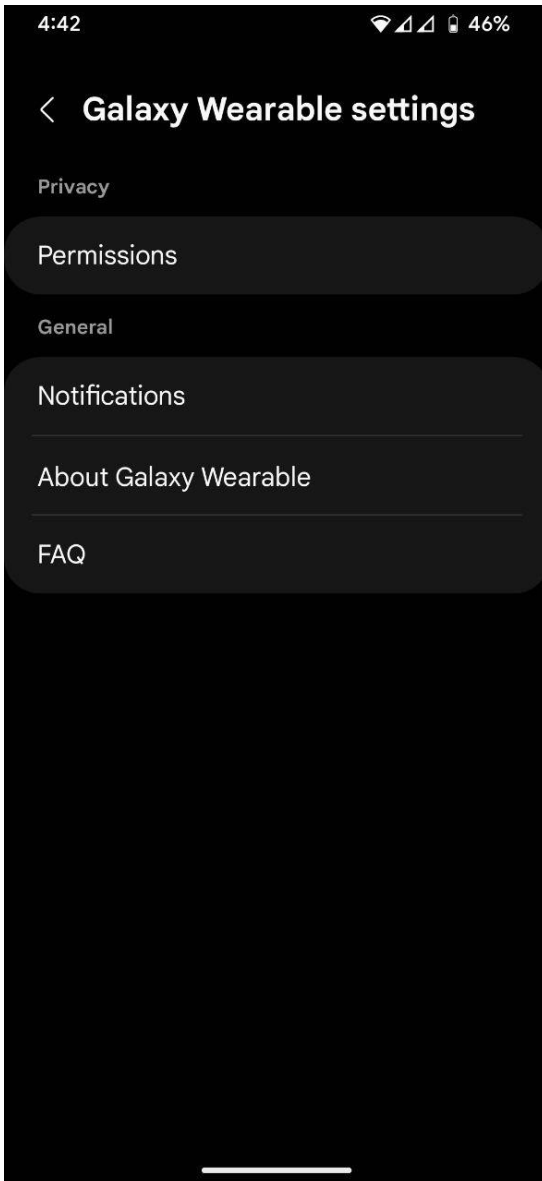
- Android 11 or later

- Installed Galaxy Wearable app

Activate QR Test Mode

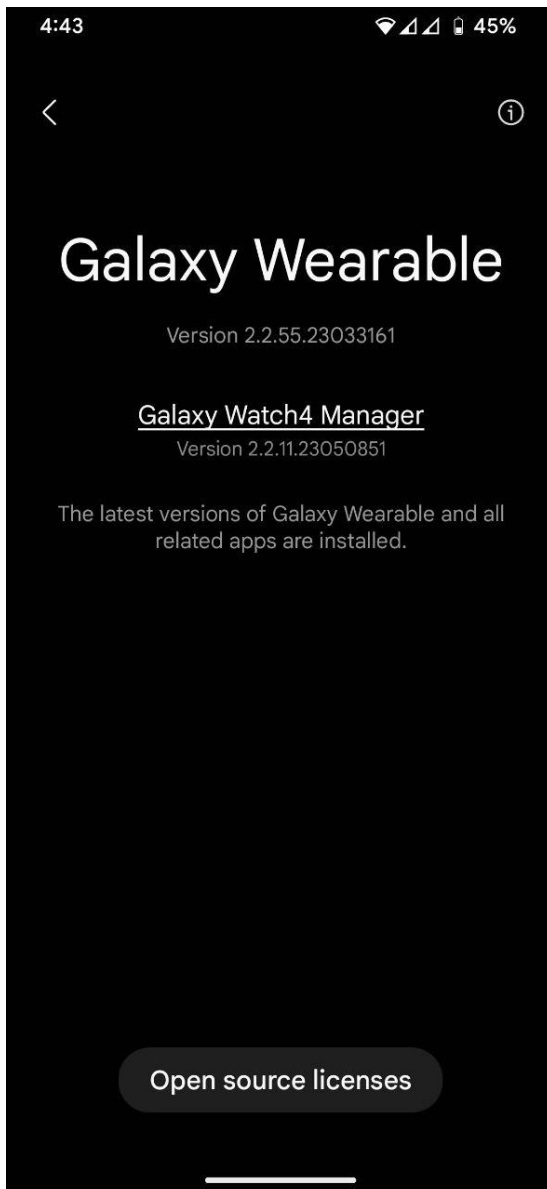
1. On the phone, open the **Galaxy Wearable** app

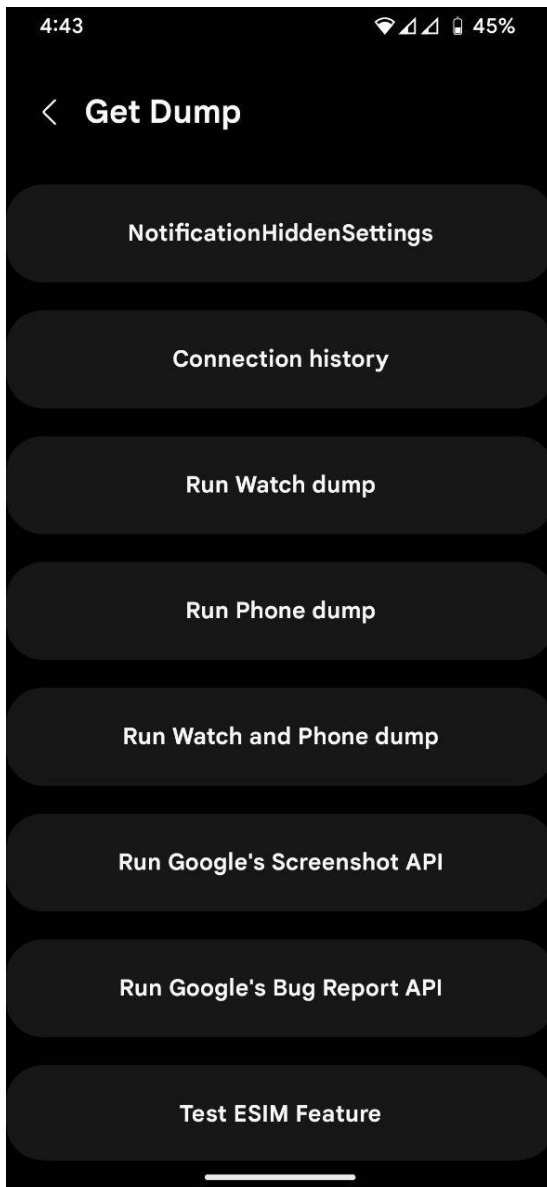


2. Open Galaxy wearable settings, then select **About Galaxy Wearable**

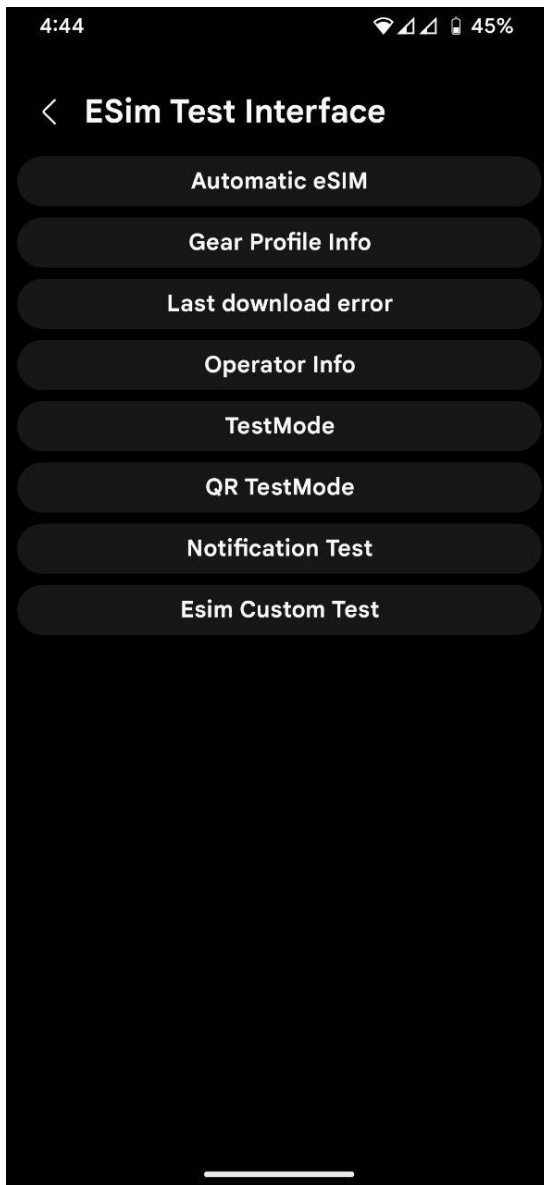


3. Tap **Galaxy Wearable** five times

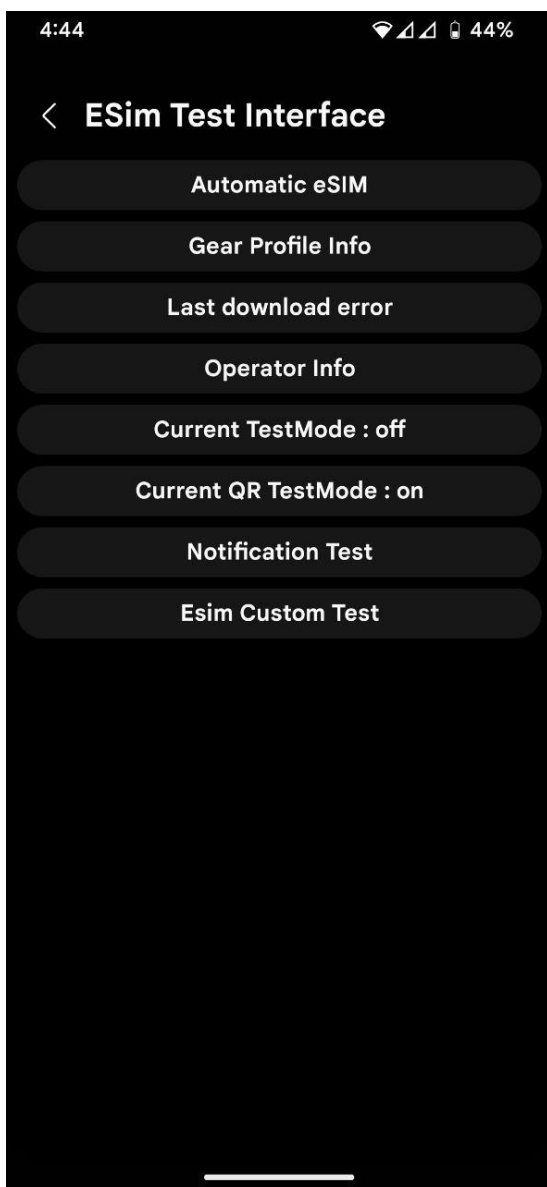


4. Select **Test ESIM Feature**

5. Select QR Test Mode

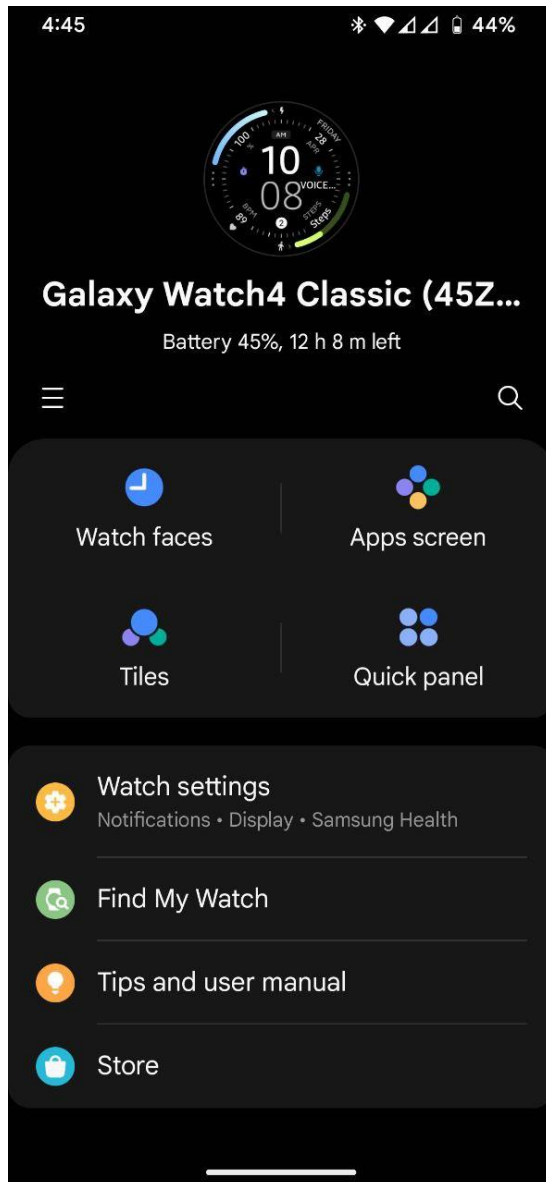


6. Tap **Current QR Test Mode** to switch it on. You've just activated the QR Test Mode.

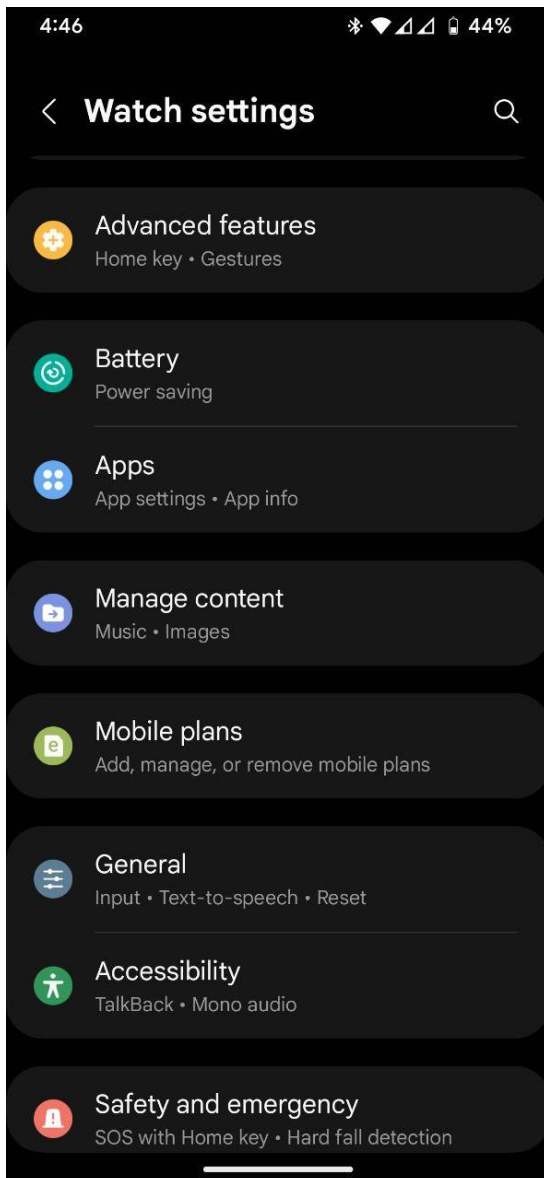


Add and Activate Mobile Plan

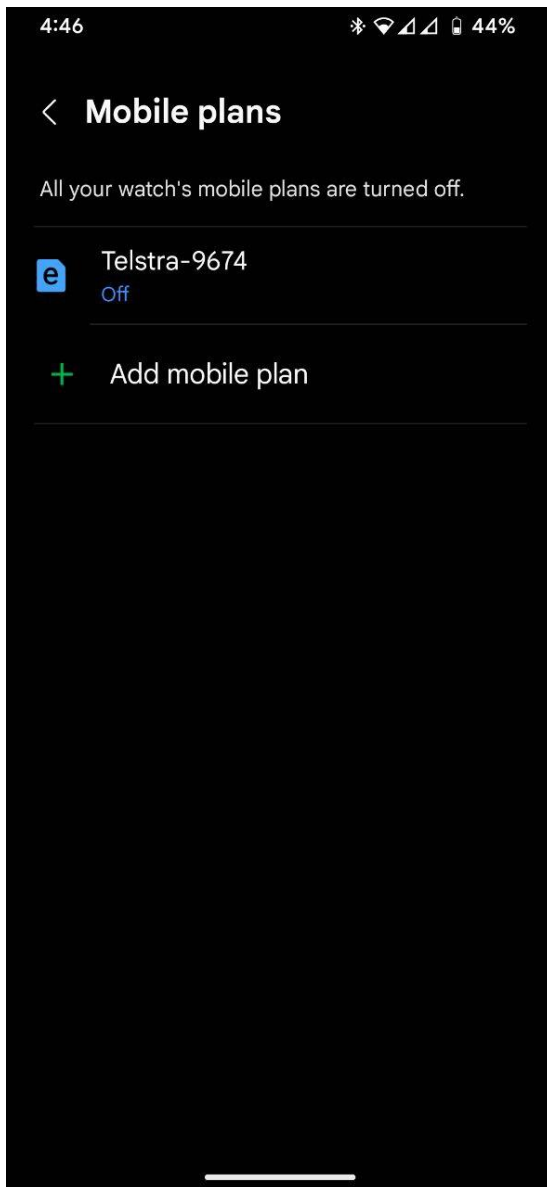
1. Go to the **Galaxy Wearable** app home page, then select **Watch settings**

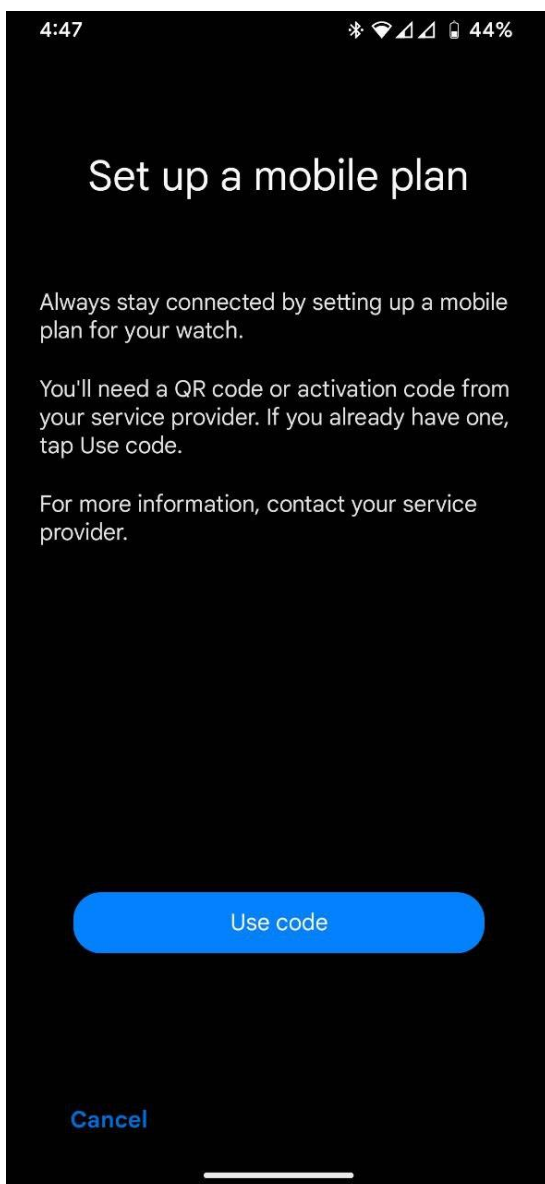


2. Select **Mobile plans**

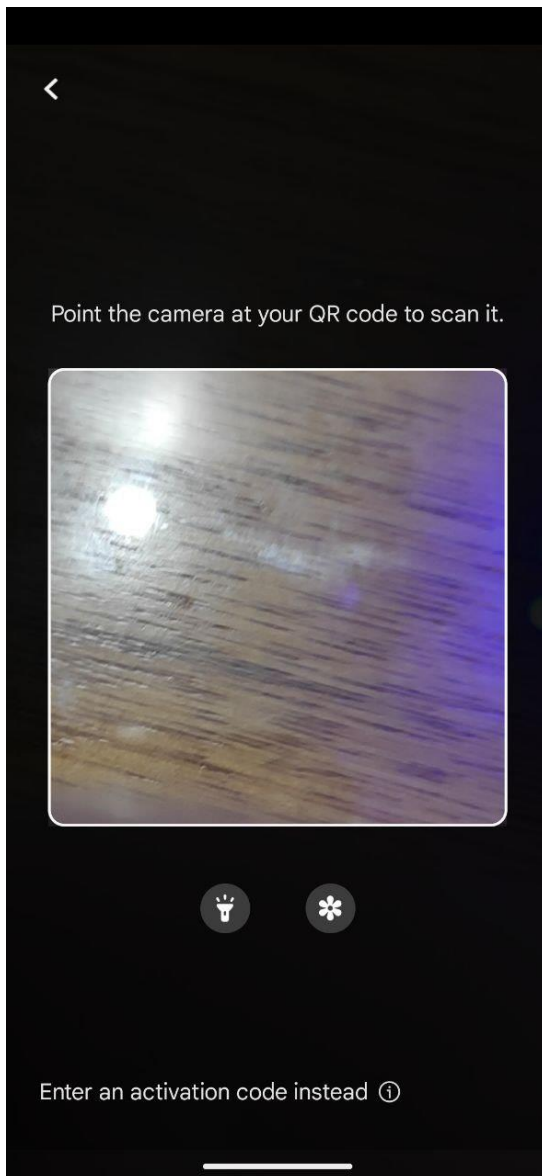


3. Select **Add** mobile plan

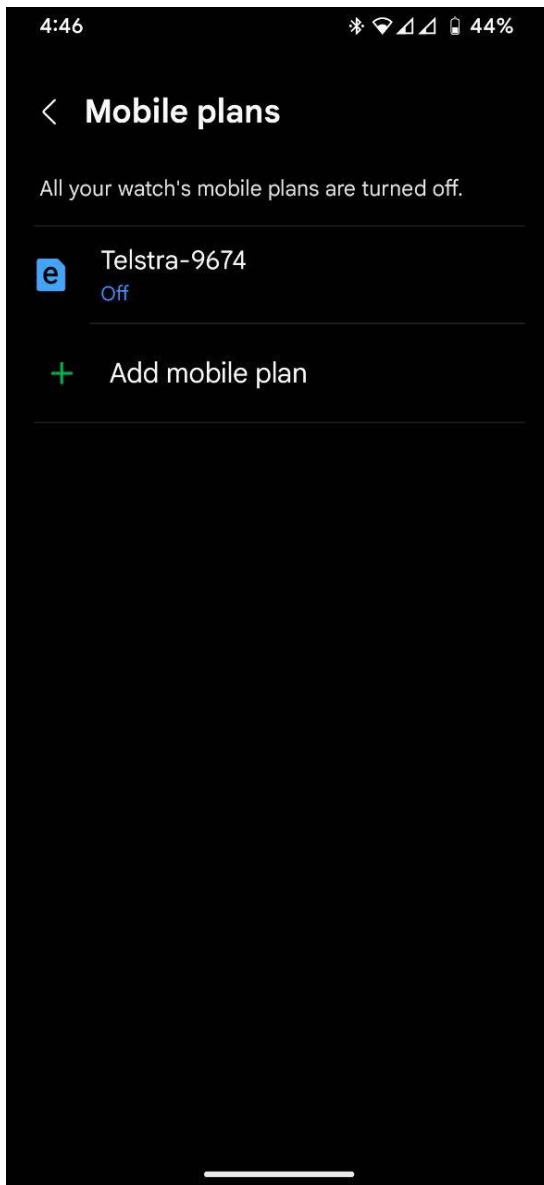


4. Tap **Use code**

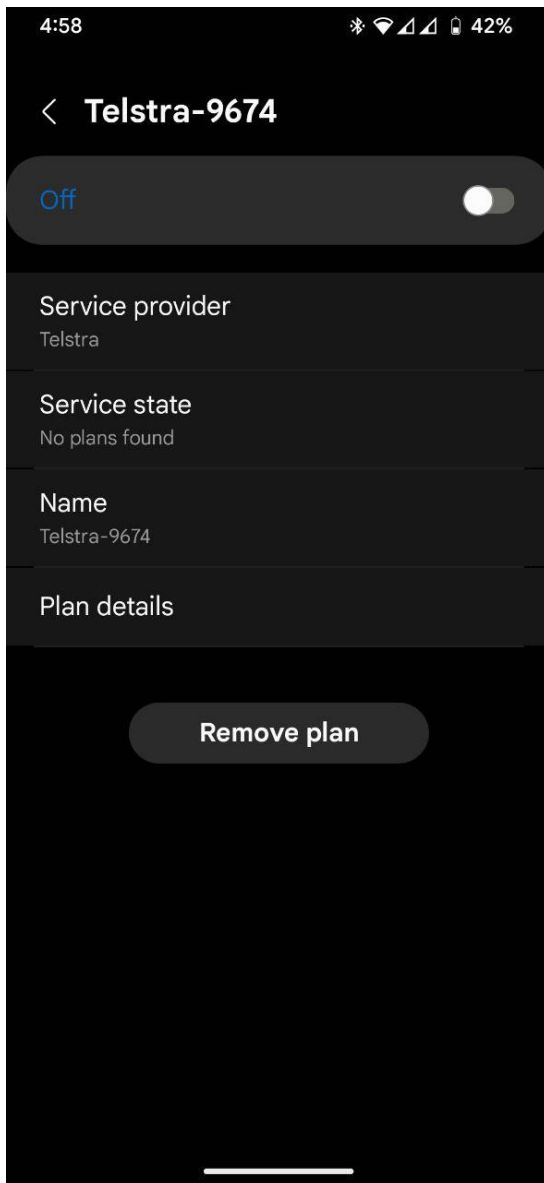
5. **Scan the code** with the QR code scanner, then follow the prompt until the plan is set.



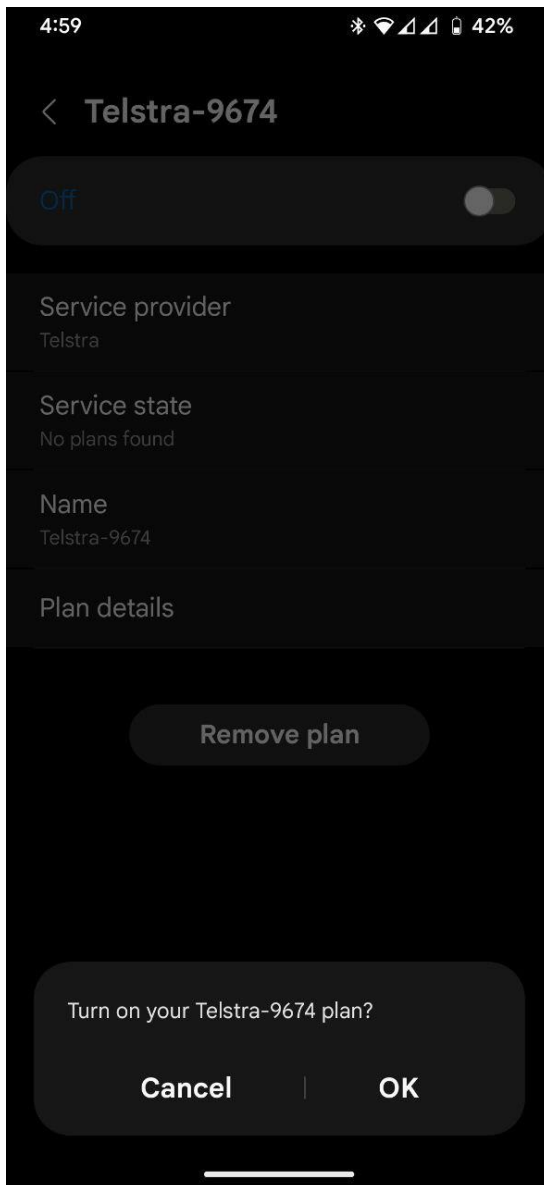
6. Mobile plan might be set in an inactive status. To activate plan, select the plan from the list.



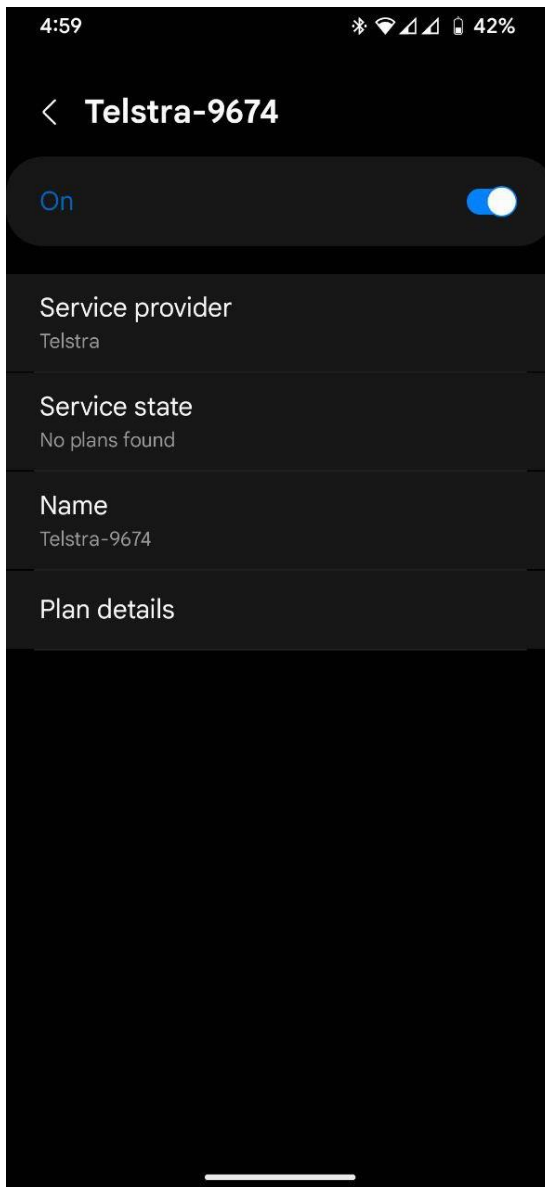
7. Toggle the switch on the plan



8. Follow the prompt until the plan is on



9. You've just activated the mobile plan added.



10. Disconnect the watch from the phone using one of the following methods:
- In the Galaxy Wearable app by disconnecting from the watch
 - In the Galaxy Wearable app by totally removing the watch connection
 - Unpair Watch from the phone's Bluetooth menu
